MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

The Prevest Denpro Limited, Unit-II Export Promotion Industrial Park, Bari Brahmana, Jammu, India -181133, which is represented by its Director Research & Academics, Dr. S.SaiKalyan, herein after may be referred as the Company.

And

Malla Reddy Dental College for Women, a constituent institute having registered office at Survey No. 137 & 139, Suraram X Roads, Jeedimetla, Quthbullapur, Hyderabad, Telangana 500055 (India) which is represented by its PrincipalDr. B.Chittaranjan, hereinafter may be referred as the Institute.

The MoU is being signed on the prospect that both the Parties collaborate on developing the joint academic and research co-operation between the two Parties.

For Collaborative Research and Academic Activities

The scope of MoU is to define a mechanism to promote interdisciplinary research; impart skill oriented training and other programs to benefit student and staff of both organizations; joint research and academic activities leading to academic excellence; new knowledge generation; innovative technology development; professional skill and competence development; vocational training capacity building and many such synergies of interdisciplinary research through collaboration and networking of Malla Reddy Dental College for Women and Prevest Denpro Limited.

1. OBJECTIVES

Malla Reddy Dental College for Women and Prevest Denpro Limited will undertake joint research work in the areas of mutual interest:

- (a) To form a nucleus for promoting excellent quality manpower in the fields of Dental Science and Allied Sciences with special emphasis on Biomaterials, Drugs, Herbals, Regenerative Science and related fields etc.
- (b) The concerned scientists of Prevest Denpro Limited and corresponding faculty members of Malla Reddy Dental College for Women will formulate joint research projects, syllabi for joint academic programs, new courses, and training for skill oriented Human Resources with due approval of both the parties and within the framework of rules and regulation governing both the organizations.
- (c) Training programs on state of art topics of interdisciplinary research for faculty, staff, and student and technical personnel of both parties within the area of co-operation will be undertaken at the premises of both Parties.
- (d) To work on collaborative research projects involving other agencies of the region and work towards development of concerned regions keeping in view the interests and philosophies of each other.

2. SCOPE AND TERMS OF INTERACTION

- (a) Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective Parties, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon by both parties.
- (b) Practical training of testing protocols for Malla Reddy Dental College for Women, students at Prevest Denpro Limited.
- (c) Joint guidance of student projects/thesis in Biomaterials, Drugs, herbals, Regenerative science and related fields etc.and other areas of national interest at Malla Reddy Dental College for Women by Prevest Denpro Limited on mutually agreeable terms.
- (d) Prevest Denpro Limited would accommodate BDS, MDS, PhD and Fellowship students in such a number that Prevest Denpro Limited deems convenient to it for the purpose of research, imparting training and others.
- (e) Prevest Denpro Limited may depute its personnel as visiting faculty at Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics of Malla Reddy Dental College for Women, to teach any of the regular Course or specialized topics.
- (f) Prevest Denpro Limited personnel, as well as research scholars, may also be allowed to enroll for their PhD at Malla Reddy Dental College for Women, subject to availability of seats, research facilities and subject to their fulfilling eligibility criteria and all other academic regulations of Malla Reddy Dental College for Women. Further, Prevest Denpro Limited may request to design and teach a Course or Courses which it deems fit to enhance quality and performance of its employees. Such Courses may be run at any mutually convenient premises.
- (g) Prevest Denpro Limited may seek assistance/guidance of Malla Reddy Dental College for Women faculty member/s in product/process modification, modernization, trouble shooting etc.
- (h) PrevestDenpro Limited will seek assistance/guidance of Malla Reddy Dental College for Women faculty member/s in clinical evaluation, clinical trials, post market surveillance, post market feedback and biocompatibility
- (i) Would allow the industrial visits of students for half/full day to provide them with an exposure to various equipment, instrument, etc.
- (j) PrevestDenpro Limited may showcase its business activities at the seminar/workshop/conference, etc at Malla Reddy Dental College for Women.
- (k) PrevestDenpro Limited may avail library, Internet, computational facilities at Malla Reddy Dental College for Women
- (1) A Research Scientist at PrevestDenpro Limited may be appointed as a Co-research

guide as per the rules of the respective parties for a student registered for PhD degree at Malla Reddy Dental College for Women. The student maybe encouraged to take up the project such that PrevestDenpro Limited desirably benefits from its outcomes.

- (m) Malla Reddy Dental College for Women sand Prevest Denpro Limited would make joint proposals for funding from agencies such as DBT, DBT, CSIR etc.
- (n) The students can carry out the part of their PhD research work or MDS/BDS project at Malla Reddy Dental College for Women and PrevestDenpro Limited depending on the nature of the work, as per rules of the respective institute depending on facilities and requirements.
- (o) There will be no restriction on the contents of the thesis and on publication of results of the thesis, subject to the condition that no Intellectual Property Rights can be secured for any part of the work which will be decided with mutual consent.
- (p) Both Malla Reddy Dental College for Women and Prevest Denpro Limited will be free to independently carry out follow-up research on the thesis work conducted under this scheme.
- (q) If the outcome of a project related to product development, process technology and design etc. which involves matter of secrecy and concern with security of the State and the Country, the same will not be allowed for publication/printing in any form such as Electronically/verbal, etc. If the outcome of a project results into an intellectual property, for which rights can be secured, it will be decided on case to case basis. Similarly, sharing of expenditure in securing such rights and income accrued through royalty etc. by the parties under the law will be decided on case to case basis after mutual consultation.
- (r) Research supervisors from both the parties will be the corresponding authors in any publication resulting from the collaborative work. All the efforts put by the student/s as a part of this MoU will be accounted for by way of reporting the work in thesis and/or paper publication except the part for which IPR needs be claimed.
- (s) Neither of the supervisors shall publish the work carried out under this MoU without knowledge of the other.
- (t) In any of the activities mentioned above, wherever financial aspects are involved, amount, payment conditions, etc. would be spelt out clearly before starting the activity.

3. EXCHANGE/DEPUTATION OF STAFF

- a. To exchange faculty/technical personnel on full-time/part time basis for a limited period not exceeding one year at a time for the purpose of implementation of joint tasks within the areas of co-operation.
- b. That the faculty/staff and research fellows registered for PhD degree may visit the other party's premises / facility for a short period in connection with their research work under joint collaboration program.
- c. That the faculty/technical personnel will be encouraged to deliver

4. **JOINT CONFERENCE/WORKSHOP/COURSES:** Both the parties agree to hold/conduct, whenever feasible, national events, joint workshops, conferences, training programs within the areas of mutual interest.

5. SHARING OF FACILITIES

- a. Both parties agree to share their respective important R&D facilities in order to promote academic and research in the areas of cooperation to intensity the high priority area program of science and technology.
- b. Both parties agree to share and utilize equipment(s), facilities, hardware, software and other materials and components developed in house in the area of co-operation if advisable within the framed rules governing both the organizations.
- c. Access to laboratory, library and other supporting facilities for jointly supervised UG, PG and Research will be provided by both parties.
- 6. PROJECT WORK OF STUDENTS: A total of 4-5 selected students of UG, PG and research in the respective areas of specialization of Institute/University will be allowed at a time for project work at PrevestDenpro Limited. Students will work in the areas of mutually agreeable areas as mutually identified by both parties.
- 7. AREAS OF MUTUAL INTEREST: The areas of co-operation will be defined and modified from time to time by the co-operation committee set up for the purpose. The areas identified for co-operation are Dental Biomaterials, Wound healing, Regenerative Sciences, Biotechnology, Biosciences, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Medicinal Chemistry, Analytical Chemistry, Physical Pharmacy, Toxic genomics, Pharmaceutical Engineering and Technology, Herbals, Food and Nutrition, etc.
- 8. TERM AND PERIOD OF MOU: This MoU will become effective upon signature by both Parties. It shall remain valid for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be modified by written mutual consent of both Parties. This MoU may be terminated by either Party with advance written notice of at least thirty (30) days. Upon notice of termination both Malla Reddy Dental College for Women and PREVEST DENPRO LIMITED agree to work in good faith to enable visiting scholars to complete their respective research programs unhindered by the termination. This MoU may be extended by mutual consent of the two Parties after the five-year period, and it must be renewed in writing.
- 9. FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS: This MoU places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either Party. These activities will be defined through separate program agreements that detail the commitment of resources (financial or otherwise) required by each Party. Subsequent program agreements must be mutually agreed and approved in writing by the authorized representatives of Both Parties.
- 10. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES: This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is intended solely as a MoU and no partnership, joint venture, employment agency,

franchise, or other form of agreement or relationship is intended. It is specifically understood between the Parties that the relationship between the parties contemplated under this MoU is strictly on a principal to principal basis. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed to the employees/representatives/students of one Party to be construed as the employees /representatives /students of the other party. However, both parties shall ensure the following:

- (a) Students and employees engaged under this programme shall strictly follow the disciplinary protocols and be professional in their conduct towards each other.
- (b) "Safety and Security" of the students during the above programme be ensured.
- 11. LAW OF THE LAND: Both parties hereby undertake to abide the respective law of the land with respect to this MoU, and terms and conditions of the agreement/s which might be entered upon under this MoU. Licenses/Approval/s or / clearance/s from statutory authorities if any, shall be obtained by the respective parties where ever applicable.
- 12. CONFIDENTIALITY:Both parties shall maintain confidentiality with respect to any confidential information of respective parties and also the confidential information in connection to the respective projects under this MoU. If required, Parties may enter into separate confidentiality agreements as per the requirements of specific or respective projects/programmes under this MoU.
- 13. DISPUTE RESOLUTION: Notwithstanding anything contained in any other statute for the time being in force, if any dispute arises between the parties in the discharge of their respective responsibilities and obligations under this MoU, same may be settled amicably between the parties, and if in case such dispute is not settled amicably between the parties, it shall be referred to The Principalof the Malla Reddy Dental College for Women and Director Research & Academics of PrevestDenpro Limited for arbitration and both shall jointly appoint or nominate an arbitrator as per the procedures in vogue for resolving the said dispute. The decision of said arbitrator shall be final as far as the dispute is concerned and the parties are bound by that decision.

The Director of Research and Academics – PrevestDenPro Limited - Dr. S.SaiKalyan will serve as the primary liaison between the two Parties to facilitate the development of future activities.

This Memorandum of Understanding completed in English is hereby signed in two (2) copies with one (1) copy remaining in the possession of each institution.
