**MRDCW MENTOR-MENTEE PROGRAM (MMP) POLICY  
DOCUMENT (APRIL, 2018)**

1. All MRDCW faculty members, regardless of seniority, will participate in the MMP as mentors.
2. Mentors will be assigned group of 10-15 students (mentees) at the beginning of each academic year.
3. Department heads will provide mentors with student academic performance data, and attendance particulars. This allows mentors to tailor their support accordingly.
4. Whenever possible, students will be assigned to the same mentor throughout their program. This continuity fosters deeper relationships and personalized guidance.
5. In case, a mentor leaves MRDCW, the respective mentees will be transferred to their new mentor. This ensures a smooth transition and continued support.
6. Strict confidentiality will be maintained by both the college and mentors. This protects the privacy of both students and faculty members.
7. Mentor-mentee meetings will be conducted periodically after every internal examination.
8. A circular will be sent by the head of the institute to all the faculty members to conduct mentor-mentee meetings after each internal examination.



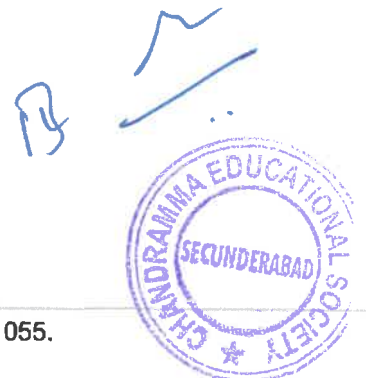
