MIDCOURSE IMPROVEMENT OF PERFORMANCE OF STUDENTS

The purpose of midcourse improvement of performance of students is to orient the students towards a comprehensive learning throughout their curriculum. Students are offered a conducive learning environment through identification of their strengths, weaknesses and areas requiring improvement through their periodical evaluation.

OBJECTIVES:

- i. To provide a collaborative appraisal and feedback on student performance involving students, faculty and parents.
- ii. To evaluate teaching modalities to cater to the needs of individual students more effectively.
- iii. To provide a student centric environment conducive to learning.



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1. TIMELY ADMINISTRATION OF CONTINUOUS INTERNAL EXAMINATIONS

The institution conducts three internal assessment exams every year to prepare the students for final university examination. The college prepares the examination schedules well in advance and informs the students about the schedules at the beginning of the academic year through the academic calendar published at the institutional website. The students are also informed about the exams via circulars. The internal examinations are strictly conducted as directed by the university. Measures taken to avoid malpractice. No electronic gadgets such as mobile phones and smart watches are allowed inside the examination hall. Frisking of all the students appearing for the examination is done before the commencement of the examination. The question papers are sent in sealed cover before the commencement of exam. The invigilators of different subjects are appointed to conduct the examination.

2. ON TIME ASSESSMENT AND FEEDBACK

All the papers will be sent to the respective departments for paper evaluation. The papers are evaluated within 15 working days. Feedback is given to the students towards identification of their shortcomings in the subject and to put up extra effort in those areas during distribution of papers.

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3. MAKEUP ASSIGNMENTS/TESTS

Special attention and retests are given to students who scored less marks. Such students are made to write make up assignments on the question paper to enable them in knowing the subject better.
