- 5. Patient Consent and Confidentiality: Ensure that research involving human subjects adheres to ethical principles, including obtaining informed consent from patients and protecting patient confidentiality.
- 6. Radiographic and Imaging Guidelines: Provide guidelines for the appropriate use and interpretation of radiographic and imaging techniques in dental research, including ethical considerations and safety protocols.
- Dental Materials and Techniques: Encourage research on dental materials, techniques, and procedures, including evaluations of their efficacy, safety, and longterm outcomes.
- 8. Prevention and Public Health: Promote research on preventive dentistry, community oral health interventions, epidemiology of dental diseases, and strategies for improving oral health literacy and awareness.
- 9. Interdisciplinary Collaboration: Encourage collaboration with researchers from related fields such as medicine, bioengineering, public health, and social sciences to address complex oral health challenges from multiple perspectives.
- 10. Case Reports and Clinical Studies: Accept case reports and clinical studies that provide valuable insights into rare or unusual dental conditions, innovative treatment approaches, or challenging clinical cases.
