2. Scope

This Research Policy forms the basics of the research ethics of the college and is implemented in all the departments and it serve as the guidelines for the functioning of the Research council of the college.

3. Custodian of the Policy

The implementation and updating of the research policy is carried out by the R&D Coordinator. The Research Policy shall have a Research and Development Committee to function under the Principal, MRDCW and Academic Council, to assist and advise in matters related to research within the college.

4. Objectives of Research Policy

The Principal objectives of the Research Policy are as follows:

- a) To develop desired awareness regarding research in the faculty of MRDCW
- b) To establish a right kind of research culture through various research initiatives and programs to encourage faculty members to publish research papers and undertake various research projects of social and academic importance.
 - d) To create awareness in the society through various research initiatives and by giving due publicity to the socially useful research projects that will be undertaken by the college.
 - e) Conduction of Research Meetings at least once in a semester and whenever required.

5. Research and Development (R&D) Centre:

Guidelines for claiming & utilizing Incentives for various academic & research achievements

Chandramma Educational Society through Malla Reddy Centre for Research Development & Sustenance (CRDS) proposes to award incentives to teaching faculty of all four colleges for various academic & research achievements.

1. Eligibility: -

- a. Teaching faculty of all institutions located at Malla Reddy Health City Campus, Hyderabad.
- b. Only for currently employed teaching faculty.
- C. All research & academic achievements achieved on or after 1st June 2021.
- d. Only for achievements forwarded with Malla Reddy Institutions name.
- e. Only for 1st & 2nd authors or to communicative Author.
- 2. Teaching faculty claiming the incentive have to submit an application (As per prescribed format Annexure-I) along with copies of achievement, Certificates/ appreciation letter received & Photography of receiving the said award to Dr. Kranti Kiran Reddy, Director, Malla Reddy Center for Research Development and Sustenance through the Dean of concerned College.
- 3. The Executive Committee of CRDS will meet quarterly and will consider all the applications received on or before end of the previous quarter.
- 4. The Incentives for various achievements (as mentioned in enclosed Annexure-2) will be decided in CRDS Executive Committee meeting after scrutinizing the documents submitted by the faculty.
- 5. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
- 6. The recommendation of executive committee will be submitted to the President Dr. Ch. Bhadra Reddy, Malla Reddy Health City for approval and forwarded to accounts section.
- 7. The account section shall maintain a faculty wise individual account and shall post the incentive amount acquired by the faculty members in his / her respective accounts.
- 8. Once the incentive amount is posted in the account of the respective faculty member, he / she is eligible to use the said incentive for any future academic / research activity.
- 9. The incentive amount can be used only after the incentive is posted in the account and not in advance.
- 10. If there is more than one author of our Institutions for the same achievement, then their incentive will be shared equally among them.
