ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE

Date: 04.08.2025

Anti-Ragging Committee will be the Supervisory and Advisory Committee on matters of Planning Action for Building and Preserving a Culture of Ragging Free Environment in the College Campus. The Anti Ragging Squad will work under the Supervision of Anti Ragging Committee and to engage in the works of checking places like Hostels, Buses, Canteens, Classrooms and other places of student congregation.

Objectives:

To root out ragging in all its forms from institution by prohibiting it by law, preventing its occurrence by following the provisions of these Regulations and punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these Regulations and the appropriate law in force.

Responsibilities:

- a) Ensures that at least one faculty member will be present at any particular time at all the locations to avoid ragging activities.
- b) Takes precautions to avoid ragging activities at other locations like bus stops and gives instructions to the student volunteers and secret informers at various boarding points.
- c) Canvases about anti-ragging in the forms of Flexes, Posters and Boards in college premises and surrounding areas where there is a chance of ragging.
- d) Arranges counselling and guidance programs arranged for the fresher's and parents regarding ragging.
- e) Takes affidavits from the students and parents regarding Ragging during the Admission.
- f) Provides helpline details inside and outside college premises.
- g) Resolves the complaint received from the victim
- h) Verifies the facts through enquiry
- i) Awards disciplinary action against culprit.



ANTI RAGGING PROSPECTUS

REGULATIONS FOR PROHIBITING RAGGING AND ANTI-RAGGING MEASURES

(This document is printed and circulated as per UGC and DCI Regulations on curbing the Menace of Ragging in Dental Colleges, 2009.

This has also reference to the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

REGULATIONS FOR PROHIBITING

RAGGING AND ANTI-RAGGING MEASURES

1. MEASURES FOR PREVENTION OF RAGGING

The Malla Reddy Dental College for Women, by following the UGC regulation, shall undertake to take the following steps:

1.1 FORMATION OF ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE (ARC) The College has an anti-ragging committee with members from within and outside the College under the chairmanship of the Principal/ Dean to oversee overall anti-ragging initiatives.

1.2 ANTI-RAGGING SQUAD (ARS) the college also has a smaller body known as the anti ragging squad for maintaining vigil, surprise inspection, supervision and patrolling. The ARS is mobile, alert and active at all times.

1.2.1 DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ANTI-RAGGING CELL (ARC)

- a. To maintain **round the clock strict vigilance** on the College campus, particularly at odd hours in the College hostels
- b. To undertake **patrolling and make surprise visits** to places vulnerable to incidents of ragging
- c. To conduct **on-the-spot enquiry** into any incident of ragging referred to it by the head of the institution or any member of the faculty or any member of the staff or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person as the case may be and the enquiry report along with the recommendations shall be submitted to the anti ragging committee for action under clause 7 of this regulation. The anti-ragging squad shall conduct an enquiry observing a fair and transparent procedure and allow adequate opportunity to the student or students accused of ragging and other witnesses to place before it the facts, documents and views concerning the incident of ragging, and considering such other relevant information as may be required.

2. ACTION TO BE TAKEN BY THE COLLEGE

On receipt of the recommendation of the anti-ragging squad or on receipt of any information concerning any reported incident of ragging, the Principal/ Dean shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made out and if so, either on his own or through a member of the anti-ragging committee authorized by him in this behalf, proceed to file a **first information report (FIR)**, **within 24 hours** of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more of the following:

- I. Abetment to ragging
- II. Criminal conspiracy to rag
- III. Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging

- IV. Public nuisance created during ragging
- V. Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- VI. Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- VII. Wrongful restraint
- VIII. Wrongful confinement
- IX. Use of criminal force
- X. Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences
- XI. Extortion
- XII. Criminal trespass
- XIII. Offences against property
- XIV. Criminal intimidation
- XV. Attempts to commit any or all of the above-mentioned offences against the victim(s)
- XVI. Threat to commit any or all of the above-mentioned offences against the victim(s)
- XVII. Physical or psychological humiliation
- XVIII. All other offences following from the definition of "ragging"

The Principal/ Dean shall forthwith report the occurrence of the incident of ragging to the District level anti-ragging committee. The institution shall also continue with its own enquiry initiated under clause 7 of this regulation and other measures without waiting for action on the part of the police / local authorities and such remedial action shall be initiated and completed immediately and in no case later than a period of 10 (ten) days of the reported occurrence of the incident of ragging.

3. ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING

The College shall issue an order to punish the student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure, and in the manner prescribed herein under:

- A) The Anti-Ragging Committee of the Institution shall take appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the anti-ragging squad.
- B) The anti-ragging committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the anti ragging squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments:
 - I. Suspension from Attending Classes and Academic Privileges
 - II. Withholding / Withdrawing Scholarship / Fellowship and other Benefits
 - III. Debarring from Appearing in any Test / Examination or other Evaluation Process
 - IV. With holding results.
 - V. Debarring from representing the institution in any Regional, National or International Meet, Tournament, Youth Festival, etc
 - VI. Suspension / expulsion from the hostel

VII. Cancellation of admission

VIII. Rustication from the institution (period to be decided by Anti Ragging Committee)

IX. Expulsion from the institution

X. Fine of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) or/ with imprisonment upto 6 months

C) An appeal against the order of punishment as recommended by the anti-ragging committee shall lie on the Principal/ Dean of Malla Reddy Dental College for Women.

4. RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF THE FRESHERS AND THEIR GUARDIANS

The fresher's, after their admission should consider **Malla Reddy Dental College for Women** as their **second home**, behaving in the most humble manner and maintaining cordial relationship with senior students, fellow students, faculty and staffs of the College. The Malla Reddy Dental College for Women shall always strive to establish a ragging free environment and in case the fresher's feel that they are subjected to any form of ragging elaborated herein above, they should immediately report the matter to any member of the anti-ragging committee, anti-ragging squad, faculty, staff or to the Principal/ Dean of the College. The guardian shall co-operate with the authority to redress the grievance and help prevent the occurrence of ragging in the College. **The identity of the fresher / guardian shall be protected and shall not be divulged.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. We do not want you to feel that you are alone and helpless. We are all with you.
2. Your Parents are there to help. Please do not feel that you will burden your parents. Talk to them freely and openly. If you are being ragged – it is not your fault. They understand that.
3. We, Malla Reddy Dental College for Women Administration is there to help – Please do not hesitate to ask for help. They will definitely help you. The local police and local administration is also there to help.
4. Your **Ragging Prevention Program** is ready to help. You can call at any time on **1800 180 5522**. It is a free phone. You can also send us an E mail on helpline@antiragging.in.
5. Anybody can register a complaint of Ragging. It does not have to be only the victim. If you notice an incidence of Ragging you must inform the call centre. It is your duty to do so.
6. You can also register a complaint of Ragging - Anonymously. You must however avoid this option because without knowing details it becomes difficult for us to take any action. We can assure you of confidentiality.
