

#### REPORT OF THE EVENT

#### INTRODUCTION:

Cervical cancer is a type of cancer that develops in the cells of the cervix, which is the lower part of the uterus that connects to the vagina. Most cervical cancers are caused by the human papilloma virus (HPV), a common sexually transmitted infection. However, not all HPV infections lead to cervical cancer, as the immune system can often clear the virus before it causes any problems.

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

<u>General objective</u>: to reduce the incidence, morbidity, and mortality associated with cervical cancer through education, early detection, prevention, and access to appropriate healthcare services.

#### Specific objectives:

- Educate individuals about the risk factors, symptoms, and consequences of cervical cancer, as well as the importance of regular screenings and vaccination against human papilloma virus (HPV), which is the primary cause of cervical cancer.
- Promote awareness of the importance of regular cervical cancer screenings, such as Pap tests (Pap smears) and HPV tests, among eligible individuals. Encourage women to seek healthcare services for cervical cancer screening, especially in underserved communities where access to healthcare may be limited.
- Empower individuals to take control of their reproductive health by advocating for themselves and others in accessing cervical cancer screening, vaccination, and treatment services. Provide resources and support to facilitate informed decisionmaking regarding cervical cancer prevention and management.

#### INTRODUCTION:

Basic Life Support, or BLS, generally refers to the type of care that first-responders, healthcare providers and public safety professionals provide to anyone who is experiencing cardiac arrest, respiratory distress or an obstructed airway. It requires knowledge and skills in **cardiopulmonary resuscitation** (CPR), using automated external defibrillators (AED) and relieving airway obstructions in patients of every age.
